## **ANNUAL REPORT 2019-20**

YAGNA (Youth Awakening for Glorious Nation) is a not-for-profit organization set up and managed by a group of doctors & medical students from Osmania & Gandhi Medical Colleges that works in the areas of holistic health, spiritual education and leadership building. Inspired by the clarion call, vision & ideals given by Swami Vivekananda, the organization has committed itself to work for the cause of nation-building. Its major initiatives include establishment of a Gurukul near Vikarabad for children from socially disadvantaged backgrounds, running Swami Vivekananda Gurukul of Human Excellence, Rural Health Centre and a Natural Farming initiative at Dhannaram Village, Vikarabad.

#### **BACKGROUND**

Our Journey started with National Youth Day Celebrations 2001. Inspired by the ideals & clarion call of Swami Vivekananda. Osmania Medical Students move forwarded for Service & Development (OMSD) in 2002. Started Health project at Nandanavanam Slum 2002-04. Another Health camps & other health initiatives by Osmania Medical Students. Fight against corruption, negligence & apathy in Govt hospitals. State level movement against User Charges in Govt hospitals & Privatisation of Medical Education 2004. Formed Patient Help Desk & Destitute Service Programme in Osmania General Hospital 2005-06. Formed a Social service society named YAGNA - Youth Awakening For Glorious Nation in year 2007 with some Core Philosophy, Core Principles & Core area of work as given below.



#### I. SWAMI VIVEKANANDA GURUKUL OF HUMAN EXCELLENCE

Swami Vivekananda Gurukul of Human Excellence (SVGHE) is a semi-residential institution set up by YAGNA at Dhannaram village, Vikarabad (75km from Hyderabad), as an endeavour towards providing man-making, character-building education to children from socially disadvantaged (poor & orphan) backgrounds in rural & tribal areas. Currently, the Gurukul has I to X Std. with teaching in English Medium and an overall strength of 180 students. Free accommodation, food, education, healthcare and personal care is provided to 77 children from socially disadvantaged background who reside in the hostel. Support another 9 Children for higher education.

- (i) Academic Curriculum The Gurukul offers a unique curriculum with spiritual education and holistic personality development as the central focus, incorporating the vision of Real Education, enunciated by Swami Vivekananda. Children learn nearly 40 subjects/skills at the Gurukul under the Holistic Education model, focusing on their all-round development. Key components of the Gurukul curriculum are as follows.
- ✓ Spiritual Education
- ✓ Yoga & Meditation

- ✓ Dance Classical & Freestyle

- ✓ Physical Education & Karate
- ✓ Indoor & Outdoor Games & Sports
- ✓ Natural & Organic Farming
- ✓ Literary & performance-oriented skill-building activities

Spiritual education is the core of the Gurukul. Children are exposed to and made to practice spiritual values, morals and values according to their age. Chanting of scriptures, recitation of Bhagavad Gita, yoga, meditation, satsangs, lectures and discussions on issues of spiritual and social importance, study of lives of great personalities, explanation and recitation of sataka (literary couplets on morals and values), daily prayers in the morning and evening, bhajans, etc. are various approaches adopted in the Gurukul to impart and develop conviction in spiritual values among the children.

The Gurukul adopts a specially designed time table with learning sessions, holistic development sessions, study hours & student activity time. Personalized attention & guidance is provided to children through a unique "Mentoring Model" where each teacher is made responsible for 10-15 students. Age-based grouping of children is adopted. Concept-based Learning is implemented through through Practical, Application-oriented, Activity-based methods (Group works, experiments, demonstrations, exercises, practice sessions, educational tours).

The Gurukul has developed and implements an innovative seven-step learning approach - Audio-visuals, Activity-based learning, Concept explanation, Oral

understanding by students, Written work, Practice & Evaluation. Classroom based learning is restricted to only 3 hours every day and in rest of the sessions, learning is imparted through practical, interactive and engaging methods. Last hour of every day is conducted

as students' activity time where each day, a different type of activity - Book review, Bala Sabha, Debate, Quiz, Cultural performances (Vedika), Competition (Pratyogita) - is organised and executed by the students itself. These are aimed at developing planning and organising skills, communication skills and performing skills.

Use of Audio, Video & TV programmes is highly encouraged to create interest on studies among children. Special practice material is developed on all concepts and subjects to improve slow learners as well as to take all students towards excellence in studies through repeated practice of learnt concepts. 'Team Learning' and 'Peer Learning' approaches are employed for improved learning among children. Regular, periodic field trips, exposure visits & study tours are a part of the curriculum. Besides the learning sessions, study hours are conducted every day for the children to bring improvement in their studies. Weekly examinations and competitions are conducted to improve the abilities of the children in a wide range of aspects.

**Staff** - Education is imparted through well-trained and qualified 17 full-time & 5 part-time teachers. The school administration is overseen by an experienced Principal. Administrative work is managed through 14 admin staff that includes Admin Manager, Store & Library in-charge, electrician cum admin asst., wardens, cooks, watchman, drivers, ayah, helpers and farmers.

(iv) Trainings - As a part of teacher empowerment programme, Swami Vivekananda Gurukul organizes workshops for all teachers. Where teachers can learn and apply new onhand methods of teaching-learning to our holistic curriculum.

Students are also encourage to learn and do the practical activities like mind management, Vedic maths, Abacus through trainers.

#### (v) Facilities provided to Children

- (a) Food & Nutrition: Balanced food menu for our Gurukul hostel children is followed by us. Children were served 4 times food with nutritious and hygiene quality. Morning breakfast with milk & malt powder, Lunch, Snacks with milk & malt powder and dinner were served. Special foods given in special occasion and weekly 3 times. Compulsory fruits and sweets serving weekly once. Our food committee monitors the food which is served to the children. Children are the part of system home management committee in hostel. (Food Menu attached- Annex)
- (b) Health Care & First Aid: Health assessment (i.e height, weight, nutrition deficiency, eye, ear & dental checkup) of every child done semi-annually. Fulltime nurse is available to take care of children. As this organization run by a group of doctors so we are more conscious about health, personal hygiene. Children and staff are trained for first aid itself in Gurukul campus only. Emergency medicine are available 24 hours and easy accessible to staff. Special care provided to sick children with special food.
- (c) Cloths & Utilities: Cloths, school uniforms, shoes, slippers and necessary supplies were fulfilled by YAGNA. New cloths were giving every year on their birthday and Diwali and special occasions. Warden and children team leader is issuing and checking all the children daily needs on daily basis.
- (d) Counselling session: It is very important to know about children mental and behavioral status. So time to time we are conducting personal counseling session for children for behavior and as well as for study planning, career planning etc. Each group is having mentor teacher to help them.

# II. YAGNA HEALTH INITIATIVE

YAGNA Health Centre Inaugurated at Dhannaram, Vikarabad, Just opposite side of Gugukul. Providing free doctor consultation with appropriate generic medicines. Every week on Sunday health camps organizing in rural and tribal area villages where medical facilities are very far and out of reach of villagers.

We have conducted School health programme in which our children conduct a survey to nearby Govt. schools for Health & Nutritional Assessment & Awareness for Students in 5th NYDC - National Youth Day celebrations on 8 Jan 2020. We have arranged a followup camps in villages for this social issues and for more detail awareness about health & nutrition.

#### III. YAGNA NATURE CONSERVATION INITIATIVE

Nature conservation is our major initiative of YAGNA. Time to time YAGNA is creating awareness and knowledge about natural farming to farmers through its campaigns. Our Gurukul children is doing practically in our own farm to grow organic vegetables and plants in Gurukul. Every year we are participating in "Harithaharam" Govt. tree plantation programme and planting tree in our school campus and road side.

- (i) Natural Farm: Naturally grown fruits and vegetables in our farms are used for Gurukul purpose. 4 acre plus land with 2 cows and 2 bull, tube-well with drip irrigation system, farm pond for rain harvesting system available where fruits and crops growing by natural method without using any chemicals and fertilizers. Training programs for farmers has been conducted time to time about nature based farming by our children to build the capacity of farmers.
- (ii) In House Preparation of Manures: Gurukul children is very keen in Natural Farming and demonstrating spread awareness to farmers in villages about benefits of natural farming so it could became zero budget & nature friendly, in which we are preparing organic natural manures like "Jeevamrutham, Beejamrutham, Agneystra, Bhramstra etc by locally available natural material like desi cow urine, dung, different types of leaves, jaggery, dicots etc. Kitchen vegetable wastes are also used to prepare manure. We are completely avoid chemicals, harmful pesticides and help to conserve environment.
- (iii) Water management: Rain water harvesting system construction is under progress in Gurukul. Eco-friendly toilet tank designed to purify water waste and to re-use for farming purpose. Drip system installed in farm to avoid access usage of ground water.
- (iv) Eco friendly construction: Gurukul building constructed with eco-friendly material to reduce the usage of less energy and depend upon natural way. Whole campus covered by green trees, garden, water harvesting roofs, Ground water recharge system, smokeless kitchen, compost pits, Eco-friendly toilet tanks, reuse and recycle of waste water.
- (v) No Plastic Campaign: To reduce the pollution due to plastic, we encourage to use only eco-friendly cloth made carry bags, our children are spread awareness in Vikarabad town during National Youth Day (Swami Vivekananda Birthday) celebrations since 5 years. We are trying to avoid usage of plastic in campus to make plastic free zone, compost pits are made to segregate the plastic waste and dispose it properly Natural farming is one of the major initiative of YAGNA. Time to time YAGNA is creating awareness and knowledge about natural farming to farmers through its campaigns. Our Gurukul children is doing practically in our own farm to grow organic vegetables and plants in Gurukul.
- (vi) Plantation: 1186 fruit tress including Mango, Amla, Water apple, Cashew, Sitaphal, Appleber, Fig, Papaya, Bamboo, Teak, Coconut, Badam, Malbar-neem tress across YAGNA maintained farms available. Grulkul campus covered with green trees around periphery boundary

**Major organic crops/farm produce are** - Leafy vegetables, seasonal vegetables, moringa and moringa leaves powder, cotton, redgram, maize, mango, sapota, papaya, guava, pomegranate, lemon etc
